Herbs:

Plant from seed: Borage

Plant from seed or transplant: Calendula, Catnip, Chamomile, Chives, Parsley, Cilantro, Dill, Fennel, Garlic Chives

Plant from transplant: Lavender, Rosemary, Thyme

Vegetables:

Plant from seed: Carrots, Collard Greens, Endive, Mustard, Green Onions, Peas, Radishes, Rutabagas, Turnips

Plant from seed or transplant: Beets, Swiss Chard

Plant from transplant: Artichokes, Asparagus, Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kohlrabi, Leeks, Lettuce, Onions, Strawberries

Plant from potatoes: Potatoes



Herbs:

Plant from seed: Anise, Fennel, Hyssop, Safflower

Plant from seed or transplant: *Basil, Catnip, Chamomile, Chives, Epazote, Horehound, Parsley, Rue, Winter Savory, Summer savory, Yarrow

Plant from transplant: Bay, French Tarragon, Garlic Chives, Germander, Lavender, Lemon Balm, Lemon Grass, Lemon Verbena, Marjoram, Mint, Rosemary, Sage, Thyme

Plant from rhizomes: Ginger, Turmeric

Vegetables:

Plant from seed: *Armenian Cucumbers, Bok Choy, *Cantaloupe, Carrots, Collard Greens, *Corn, *Cucumbers, Mustard, Green Onions, Peas, Radishes, Spinach, *Summer Squash, Turnips, *Watermelon

Plant from seed or transplant: Beets

Plant from transplant: Artichokes, Asparagus, Blackberries, *Grapes, *Ground Cherry, Lettuce, Onions, *Peppers, Swiss Chard, *Tomatillos, *Tomatoes

*Wait to plant these until past the last frost date. This is typically February 15th, but in the outlying part of the valley it can be into the beginning of March. The best way to know is to watch weather forecasts.

**If it has been a warmer than normal winter, beets, Bok choy, lettuce, peas and spinach will not do well planted this month.



Herbs:

Plant from seed: Anise, Fennel, Hyssop, Safflower

Plant from seed or transplant: Basil, Catnip, Chamomile, Chives, Epazote, Horehound, Parsley, Rue, Winter Savory, Summer Savory, Yarrow

Plant from transplant: Bay, French Tarragon, Garlic Chives, Germander, Lavender, Lemon Balm, Lemon Grass, Lemon Verbena, Marjoram, Mint, Rosemary, Sage, Thyme

Plant from rhizomes: Ginger, Turmeric

Vegetables:

Plant from seed: Armenian Cucumber, Cantaloupe, Carrots, Corn, Cucumber, Green Onions, Malabar Spinach, Okra, Peanuts, Pumpkin, Radishes, Summer Squash, Sunflowers, Watermelon, Winter squash

Plant from transplant: Artichokes, Blackberries, Cucamelon, Eggplant, Grapes, Ground Cherries (I have been able to grow Ground Cherries just fine from seed), Peppers, Sweet Potatoes, Tomatillos, Tomatoes

Plant after March 15: Beans, Black-eyed Peas, Edamame, Lima Beans, Peanuts, Roselle Hibiscus, Snake or Asparagus Beans



Herbs:

Plant from seed: Anise, Caraway, Catnip, Chamomile, Chives, Epazote, Fennel, Horehound, Hyssop, Parsley, Rue, Safflower, Winter Savory, Summer Savory, Yarrow

Plant from transplant: Basil, Bay, French Tarragon, Garlic Chives, Germander, Lavender, Lemon Balm, Lemon Verbena, Marjoram, Mint, Sage, Thyme

Vegetables:

Plant from seed: Armenian Cucumber, Beans(Lima*, Snap and Asparagus/Snake), Black-eyed peas, Cantaloupe, Corn*, Cucumber, Edamame, Green Onions, Luffa, Malabar Spinach, Okra, Peanuts, Roselle Hibiscus, Summer Squash*

Plant from transplants or seeds: Armenian Cucumber, Cantaloupe, Cucumber, Luffa, Green Onions, Malabar Spinach, Roselle Hibiscus, Summer Squash*

Plant from slips: Sweet Potatoes

*Plant through April 15th



Herbs:

Plant from seed or transplant: Basil

Vegetables:

Plant from seed: Black-eyed peas, Edamame, Yard long Beans

Plant from seed or transplant: Amaranth, Armenian Cucumber, Cantaloupe, Okra,
Malabar Spinach, Roselle Hibiscus

Plant from slips: Sweet Potatoes



Vegetables:

*Start seeds indoors this month for a monsoon planting of tomatoes and peppers.

Plant seeds or transplants: Amaranth, Armenian Cucumbers, Black-Eyed peas, Cantaloupe,
and Snake Beans

Plant from slips: Sweet potatoes are planted from sweet potato slips and this is the last month of
the year that they can be planted.

July

Vegetables:

Through Mid-July:

Plant from seed or transplant: Armenian Cucumbers

Plant All Month Long:

Plant from seeds or transplant: Cantaloupe, Winter squash, Pumpkin

Plant from seeds: Snake Beans, Black-Eyed Peas, Shallots (onion sets)

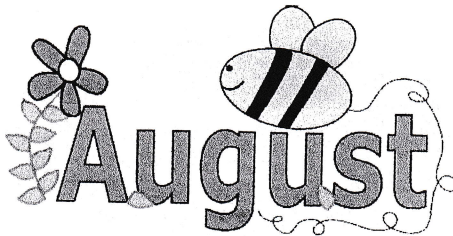
Plant from transplant: Peppers

Plant After July 15th:

Plant from seeds: Corn, Tepary Beans, Pinto Beans, Pole Beans, Bush Beans

Plant from seeds or transplant: Amaranth, Cucumber, Basil

Plant from transplant: Tomatoes, Tomatillos, Eggplant



Vegetables:


Plant from seed: Pumpkins, Winter squash, black-eyed peas through August 15th.

Plant from transplants: Tomatillos, tomatoes through August 15th

After August 15th:

Plant from seeds: Bok Choy, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Celery, Collard Greens, Cucumber, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Mustard, Swiss Chard, Summer Squash, Turnips.

*If the temperatures are hotter than normal you may want to wait to plant until September.



September

Vegetables:

Plant before September 15th

Plant from seeds: Summer squash, and Beans.

Plant All Month:

Plant from seeds: Bok Choy, Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Celery, Chard, Collard Greens, Cucumbers, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Leeks, Mustard, Green Onions, Parsnips, Radishes, Rutabagas, Spinach, Turnips, I'toi Onions.

Plant from transplants: Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Celery, and Lettuce

Plant After September 15th:

Plant from seeds: Beets, Peas

Plant from transplants: Strawberries

Plant from potatoes: Potatoes



Vegetables:

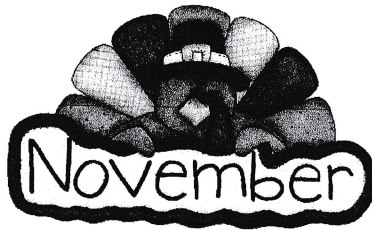
Plant from seed: Beets, Carrots, Endive, Green Onions, Leeks, Lettuce, Parsnips, Peas, Radishes, Rutabagas, Spinach, Turnips

Plant from seed or transplant: Bok Choy, Broccoli, Cabbage, Chinese Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collard Greens, Kale, Kohlrabi, Leeks, Mustard, Swiss Chard

Plant from transplants: Brussel Sprouts, Celery, Strawberries

Plant from cloves: Garlic (Soft neck garlic grows best here)

Plant from bulbs: I'toi Onions



Herbs: Anise, Borage, Caraway, Catnip, Chervil, Chives, Cilantro, Dill Fennel, Garlic Chives, Lavender, Lemon Balm, Marjoram, Mint, Oregano, Parsley, Rosemary, Sage, Winter Savory, Thyme, Yarrow

Vegetables:

Plant from seeds: Carrots, Parsnips, Peas, Radishes, Rutabagas, Spinach, Turnips

Plant from seeds or transplants: Arugula, Asparagus, Beets, Bok Choy, Broccoli, Cabbage, Chinese Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collard Greens, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Green Onions, Lettuce, Mustard, Swiss Chard

Plant from transplants: Brussels Sprouts, Celery, Globe Artichoke, Leeks, and Strawberries (For best results, plant strawberries by November 15th)

Plant from onion sets: Plant l'ittoi Onions

*November is the best month to plant onion plants



Herbs: Borage, Chamomile, Chives, Cilantro, Dill Fennel, Garlic Chives, Catnip, Fever Few, Horehound, Lavender, Parsley, Rosemary, Thyme

Vegetables:

Plant from seeds: Carrots, Peas, Radishes, Rutabagas, Turnips

Plant from transplants or seeds: Beets, Bok Choy, Broccoli, Cabbage, Chinese Cabbage, cauliflower, Collard Greens, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Mustard, Green Onions, Spinach, Swiss Chard

Plant from transplants: Asparagus, Celery, Leeks, Onions, and Strawberries
